COURSE TITLE: APPLIED BASIC CRITICAL CARE NURSING

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

To equip nurses with the Hands-On skills, knowledge and attributes essential for the provision of safe and effective care to critically ill patients in Intensive care units and High Dependency Units (ICUs and HDUs).

Modules to be covered

- Basic Concepts of critical care
- Airway management, Ventilation, Electrolytes and Acid-Base balance
- Concepts of body electrolytes and body fluids
- Basic obstetric care

- Demonstrate skills of assessment of critically ill patient
- Apply knowledge of monitoring and Care a critically ill patient
- Describe the common drugs used for management of critically ill patients in ICU
- Demonstrate knowledge and skills of cardiopulmonary resuscitation
- Apply skills of quality Nursing documentation
- Apply knowledge and skills of profession communication
- Apply knowledge and skills different airway management techniques
- Describe concepts of body fluids and electrolytes
- Demonstrate knowledge and skills in assessment of pregnancy mother
- Apply principles and concepts caring obstetric woman
- Demonstrate knowledge and skills in Nursing management of obstetric emergencies



Eligible candidates

- I. Must be a registered Nurse with minimum education of Diploma and above from any institutions recognized by TNMC
- II. Must have a valid license from TNMC
- III. Nurses working or expecting to work in critical care setting (ICUs and HDUs) are encouraged to apply

Teaching Modality and Facilitators

The course will be delivered in both class sessions (Theory) and clinical sessions for hands-on activities, it will be offered by critical care and cardiovascular nurse specialists and other ICU experienced facilitators

Course Duration

The course will take 6 months as per Ministry of health guidelines
